Partner Programs

Chatham-Kent Student Nutrition Program Student Nutrition Program- \$27,000

The aim of this program is to ensure that all children have access to healthy, nutritious food every school day, regardless of socioeconomic background or situation.

Direct Services

Foodbank- \$60,000

The Tilbury Information and HELP Centre's Food Bank distributes food to individuals and families who have difficulty purchasing enough food to avoid hunger as a result of job loss, illness, or other increasing costs.

Prosperity Roundtable- \$75,783.74

The Prosperity Roundtable is Chatham-Kent's strategic response to reducing poverty and its resultant economic, psycho-social and health impacts. The roundtable is made up of four community action teams - *Social Determinants of Health, Social Inclusion, Education and Food Security*.

Operation Cover-Up- \$15,000

Operation Cover-Up, in partnership with The Salvation Army, helps families in need stay warm during the winter by providing them with gently used winter coats.

Women's Leadership Council- \$8,320.00

Provides grants and other supports to improve the lives of women and their families in vulnerable situations.
